

# The Summer Sunglasses Case

Crochet Pattern

#### Materials

#### - Hook - 5.50 mm

- Yarn - Medium weight 4

(Bernat Handicrafter Cotton Yarn was used in this photo)

- \* 25 grams approx
- Scissors
- Yarn needle

### Stitch Legend

st(s) - stitch(es)

Rw - row

ch(s) - chains(s)

sl st - slip stitch

XSC - crossed single crochet

BO - Bobble stitch

YO - yarn over (the hook)

YU - yarn under (the hook)

\* - repeat

# **Pattern**

Begin with a slip knot on your hook and ch 24 to begin.

## **Row** - 1

- Into the 2nd ch from the hook, place 1 SC, then continue to place 1 SC into each chain until the end of the row
- ch 1 and turn (You will have 23 stitches in total)

### **Row - 2**

- into the very first st, place 1 SC then you will place 1 BO into the next st (Bobble Stitch = YO and insert your hook into the st and pull up a loop. YO and pull through the first two loops. You now have two loops remaining on your hook. Repeat the YO process two more times into that same stitch so that you end up with 4 loops on your hook. You will then YO and pull through all four loops. Then you will move onto the next st and insert 1SC. This is what creates your Bobble.)

continue crocheting the Bobble pattern to the end of the row. (Bo, SC, Bo, SC ...etc) Your last st will be a SC.

If you are changing colours here, snip your yarn and fasten off. Then with the new colour, place
a slip knot onto your hook and slip st to join where you left off and ch 1. If you are not changing
colours, just ch1 and turn your work.

## **Row - 3**

into the very first st and every st of this row, place 1 XSC

(XSC = You will insert your hook into the stitch and YU. This means, you will hook the yarn by making sure your hook is on top as you pull the loop through. Then you have two loops on your hook. At this point, YO as usual and pull through both loops.)

- ch 1 and turn your work

Row -  $4 \rightarrow 24$ 

\* repeat Row 3



Once you have 24 rows, you will ch 1 and rotate your panel so you can work along the side of your fabric. We are adding a border round here of SC stitches all the way around your panel. This will make it easier to sew the sides in a moment. Continue to place 1 SC into the side of each row - if you are working up the sides - and 1 SC into each st along the top and bottom until your border is complete.

Here, you want to leave a long tail so that you can stitch your three sides together before you snip your yarn. (I usually like to leave approximately three lengths worth of yarn.)



Fold the panel in half with the bobble side facing out. We will be sewing with our right side facing out. For this project, I used the mattress stitch method but you can sew your sides using any method of your choice.



Once you have sewn three of your sides, snip off your yarn and weave in any ends. You are done!
