



The Crochet Coffee Cozy

Crochet Pattern

Materials

- **Hook** : 3.75 mm
- **Yarn** : Super Fine weight 1 (Aunt Lydia's Fashion Thread 3 was used in this photo)
*Approx 30g. You may also use a medium 4 weight yarn like Bernat's Handicrafter Cotton. These are high heat tolerant yarns. Acrylic is not recommended for this project.
- **2 buttons** for fastening the cozy
- **Thread** to sew your buttons
- **Sewing needle**
- **Scissors**
- **Yarn Needle**

Stitch Legend

- *R* – row
- *st(s)* – *stitch(es)*
- *ch(s)* – *chains(s)*
- *sl st* – *slip stitch*
- *SC* – *single crochet*
- *DC* – *double crochet*
- *FPDC* – *front post double crochet*
- * – *repeat*

* Cozy dimensions - 3 inches in height by 8.5 inches in length (7.5 cm X 21.75 cm)

Pattern

Begin with a slip knot on your hook and ch 20 to begin.

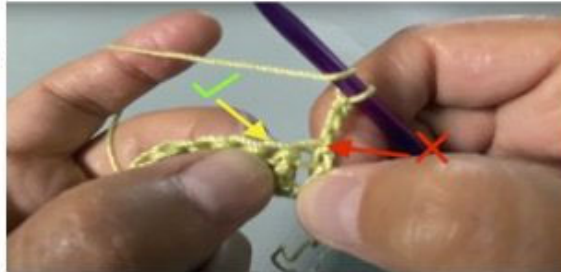
R – 1

- Into the 4th ch from the hook, place 1 DC
- Continue placing 1 DC into each st to the end of your row
- ch 3 and turn your work

You will have a **total of 18 sts** at the end of this row and every row from here on.

R – 2

- Into each st of this row, place 1 DC (remember not to st into the bottom of your ch 3 as that counts as a stitch)
- the very last st should be placed into the top of the chain 3 you find at the end of this row
- ch 3 and turn



R – 3

- Place 1 FPDC around the post of the next st
- continue to place 1 FPDC around the post of each st to the end of the row until you have one st left, which should be the chain 3 from the previous row
- into the top of the chain 3, place 1 regular DC (As always you still have 18 sts in total)
- ch 3 and turn

R – 4 -> 31

- Repeat Row 2 & 3

R – 32

- Repeat Row 2
- Ch 1 and turn

R – 33

- Into the very first st, place 1 SC and then into the next 2 sts
- Ch 3, skip 3 sts, place 1 SC into each of the next 6 sts, ch 3, skip 3 sts, insert 1 SC into each of the last 3 sts
- Ch 3 and turn your work

You have just created your buttonholes.



R – 34

- Place 1 DC into each stitch to the end of the row

* This includes working into each chain created for the button holes.



If you do not want to create a border, then your cozy is complete. Snip your yarn and fasten off. You will now move onto sewing your buttons.

Creating a Single Crochet Border

- Do not snip your yarn once you complete R 34 and do not turn your work
- Ch 1, place 3 SC into the same st and then continue to work around the corner and down the side of your work, all the way around.

Note: * The side of each Row will get 2 SC into the side of each DC st.

* Each corner will have 3 SC placed onto it



Once you have completed your border, you may snip off your yarn and fasten off. Now you will need to sew on your buttons and your cozy will be ready to use!
