

# The Easiest Crochet Cowl

#### Crochet Pattern

## Meterials

Hook: 9.0 mm

 Yarn: Bulky 5 (Charisma by Loops & Threads was used to crochet the cowl pictured.)
\*Approx 85 - 100g.

- Scissors
- Yarn Needle

## Stitch Legend

- Rnd round
- st(s) stitch(es)
- ch(s) chains(s)
- sl st slip stitch
- HDC half double crochet
- BBL back bottom loops
- \* repeat





## Pattern

Begin with a slip knot on your hook and ch 65 to begin. Then, into the very first chain, insert your hook and sl st to join your chain into a circle. You will now continue to work in the round.

### Rnd - 1

- Ch 1, then place 1 HDC into the first st
- Continue placing 1 HDC into each st to the end of your round
- at the end, sl st to the top of your first HDC to join and you have completed Rnd 1

You will have a total of 65 sts at the end of this round and every round from here on.

### Rnd - 2

 Ch 1, place 1HDC into the back bottom loop (BBL) of the first st and into every st of the round.



This will push the loops of the stitch forward to create a "knit" like effect.

- at the end of your round sl st to join

### Rnd - 3 -> 26

- \*Repeat Rnd 2 until you reach Rnd 26 (or to your desired depth)
- at the end of rnd 26, sl st to join then snip your yarn and fasten off.

Weave in your ends and you are done!

## Congratulations! Your EASY COWL is complete!



This cowl measures 11 1/2 inches or 29.5 cm in depth.
