# Description

This blanket measures 42.5" (108 cm) in width and 68" (174 cm) in length.

# **Materials**

- Hook: 6.5 mm
- Yarn: Bulky weight 5 (Caron Cakes: Colorama Halo in the colour Rose Garden 4 @
   227g each = 908g total was the amount I used for the blanket pictured.)
- Scissors
- Yarn needle

## Legend

```
R-Row
```

st(s) - stitch(es)

sl st - slip stitch

ch(s) - chains(s)

DC - Double Crochet

SK - skip

\* - repeat

### Pattern

Begin with a slip knot on your hook and ch 144.

- R 1 into the 5 ch from the hook, place 1 DC, then continue to place 1 DC into each ch to the end of the row = 141 sts in total. Ch 3 and turn. (This will count as a DC)
- R 2 DC into the next st,
  - Ch 1, sk a st, DC into next st \*Repeat this to the end of the row until you have 3 sts left
  - Ch 1, sk next st, then DC into each of the last two sts (You should still have 141 sts in total, including chain stitches. This should be your total for every row for the whole blanket.)
  - Ch 3 and turn.
- R 3 1 DC into next, ch 1, sk next st, DC into each st to end until you have 3 sts left
  - Ch 1, sk next st, then DC into each of the last two sts, ch 3 and turn
- R 4 --> R 126 \*Repeat R 3



#### R 127 - \* Repeat Row 2

R 128 – 1 DC into ea st (including the ch spaces) to the end of the row. Then snip your yarn and fasten off. Weave in your ends.
