

# The Easy Faux Fur Pom Beanie

#### Crochet Pattern

### Meterials

- Hook: 9.0 mm
- Yarn: Bulky 5 (Charisma by Loops & Threads was used to crochet The beanie pictured.)
   \*Approx 85 - 100g.
- 1 faux fur pom
- · Thread to sew your pom
- Thread needle
- Scissors
- Yarn Needle

# Stitch Legend

- R row
- st(s) stitch(es)
- ch(s) chains(s)
- sl st slip stitch
- SC single crochet
- HDC half double crochet
- BLO back loops only
- FBL front bottom loop
- \* repeat

### Pattern

Begin with a slip knot on your hook and ch 30 to begin. This represents the height of your hat. For a child, you will need less chains.

#### R-1

- Into the 2nd ch from the hook, place 1 HDC
- Continue placing 1 DC into each st to the end of your row
- ch 1 and turn your work

You will have a total of 29 sts at the end of this row and every row from here on.

#### R-2

- Into each st of this row, place 1 HDC into the front bottom loop (FBL) of the st
- ch 1 and turn

#### R - 3

- Place 1 HDC into BLO of each st to the end of the row
- ch 1 and turn

You should still have 29 sts



#### R-4->30

- Repeat Row 2 & 3
- \* This gave me a length of 20 inches (51 cm) which is enough to wrap around my head snuggly. (An average adult head circumference is 22" or 56cm and I always take off an inch or two so the hat fits snug as it will stretch.)



\*Do not snip your yarn here!

#### Sewing your seem

- Fold your panel in half so that your right side is facing out
- Make sure to line up your sts from each edge

You will then slip stitch the two edges together by inserting your hook into the st
of the front edge and then inserting into the front loop only of the back edge for



- Once you reach the end, you will have created a tube
- You will then crochet a simple finishing round along the edge of this opening by placing 1
   SC into the end of each row. So if you had 30 rows you should have 30 sts around this opening.
- Once that is done, snip your yarn and weave in your end as that side will be the brim side
  of your hat.

Lastly, you will turn your "tube" inside out. Then cut a long piece of yarn approximately 12" or 31cm and thread your yarn needle. You will now sew the raw edge end of your tube so as to close it shut. You may want to weave your needle in and out all along the edge or follow what I do in the video. With bulkier yarn, I like to sew 'crossways' until the opening is completely closed.

Once you are done closing up the end, turn your hat right side out.

Lastly, you will sew the pom to the top of your hat. My pom has a snap attachment to it, so with needle and thread, I sewed the bottom part of the snap to the top of the hat and then snapped on my pom. This is great for when you have to throw your hat in the wash.

Simply unsnap the pom before throwing it in.
