

# Mini produce Bag

Crochet Pattern

Materials	Stitch Legend
	st(s) - stitch(es)
Hook – 5.5 mm	ch(s) - chains(s)
Yarn – medium weight 4	sl st – slip stitch
approx 100g	Sk - skip
(Red Heart Amore yarn was	SC - single crochet
used in the pictured item)	HDC - half double crochet



## \*Begin with a slip knot.

### Row 1

- ch 40 + 1 = 41 chains
- into the 2nd chain from the hook, insert 1 SC
- then place 1 SC into each ch across until you reach the end
- Into the last ch which will be your 40<sup>th</sup> st, place 2 more SC into that same st (This will help you round the bend so you can continue to work along the bottom of the chain.



- Continue placing 1 SC into each stitch along the bottom of the chain row until you come to the very first st you worked into and place 1 extra SC into that one
- SI st to join your round
- You will end up with 82 stitches in total for round 1



#### Round 2

- Ch1 and insert 1 SC back into the sl st you just did
- 1SC into each st all the way around
- sl st to join = 82 Stitches

### Round 3

- Ch 3, sk the next st and insert 1 HDC into the next st
- Ch 1, sk the next st, 1 HDC into the next st\*
- · repeat this until you get back to the first ch 3, sl st to join = 82 stitches

## Round 4

- ch 3, (HDC into ch space of previous round, ch 1)\*
- · repeat continuously without sl st anymore

To avoid creating a "seam" in your bag, do not slip st to join your rounds. Just keep working this pattern until you reach your desired height.

- Once you are happy with the height, sl st into the last st to join your round.
