

The Offset Granny Square

Crochet Pattern

Materials

- **Hook** : any size it to match yarn weight
- **Yarn** : any weight yarn
(2 colours in contrast is recommended)
- **Scissors**
- **Yarn Needle**

Stitch Legend

- *Rnd* – round
- *st(s)* – *stitch(es)*
- *ch(s)* – *chains(s)*
- *DC* – *double crochet*
- *SC* - *single crochet*
- *BLO* - *back loops only*
- * - *repeat*



Pattern

Begin with a cinch circle or magic ring and ch 5. (This will count as a DC, ch 2.)

Rnd – 1

- Into the ring, you will place 3 DC, ch 2*
- continue to repeat *(3 DC, ch 2) into the ring until you have done this 3 times
- then place another 2 DC into the ring and sl st into the top of the 3rd ch. Round 1 is complete.
- snip your yarn and fasten off

At the end of Round 1, you will have 12 sts in total. (This does not include the ch spaces.)



Rnd – 2

- with your secondary colour, place a sl knot onto your hook
- into the centre st of any side, sl st to join and ch 5 or place a self contained DC, ch 2



- into the same st place 3 DC, ch 1. This forms part of your first offset corner
- Into the centre st of the next side place (3 DC, ch 2, 3 DC, ch 1)*



- Repeat * for 2 more times until you come back to the first partial corner

- Then place 2 DC into the first st worked to complete the first corner
- Sl st to the top of the 3rd ch and Rnd 2 is complete. Do not snip your yarn.





At the end of Round 2, you will have 24 sts in total.

(This does not include the ch spaces.)

Rnd – 3

- sl st into the corner space and ch 1
- place 1 SC, ch 2 , 1 SC into that space
- continue placing 1 SC into the BLO of each st across the side except for the ch 1 between your corners. Just skip over those chains. You should have 7 sts so far.
- into the next corner space place 1 SC, ch 2, 1 SC*
- *repeat this along each side until you get to the first corner again.
- sl st to the first SC to join your round.
- snip your yarn and fasten off.

Round 3 is complete and you should now have 32 sts in total.

Voila! You have crocheted the Offset Granny Square.
