

Picnic Placemat

Crochet Pattern

Materials	Stitch Legend
*Yarn – 110 g of medium weight 4 Bernat Handicrafter Cotton was used in the photo	R – row st(s) – stitch(es) ch(s) – chains(s) sl st – slip stitch SC – single crochet HDC – half double crochet y/o – yarn over
*Hook – 5.00mm / H/8 *Scissors *Yarn Needle	



Begin with a Slip Knot

Row	Description	End stitch count
R - 1	- Ch 40 +2	42
R - 2	- into the 3 rd ch from the hook, you will place HDC Herringbone stitch ➔ yarn over and insert your hook into the the 3 rd ch from the hook and y/o to pull up a loop (you will now have 3 loops on your hook) ➔ continue to pull that last loop through the 2 nd loop (you will now have 2 loops remaining on your hook)    ➔ yarn over and pull up a loop through the last two loops You have just completed your first HDC Herringbone stitch!	

Congrats! You are done!
