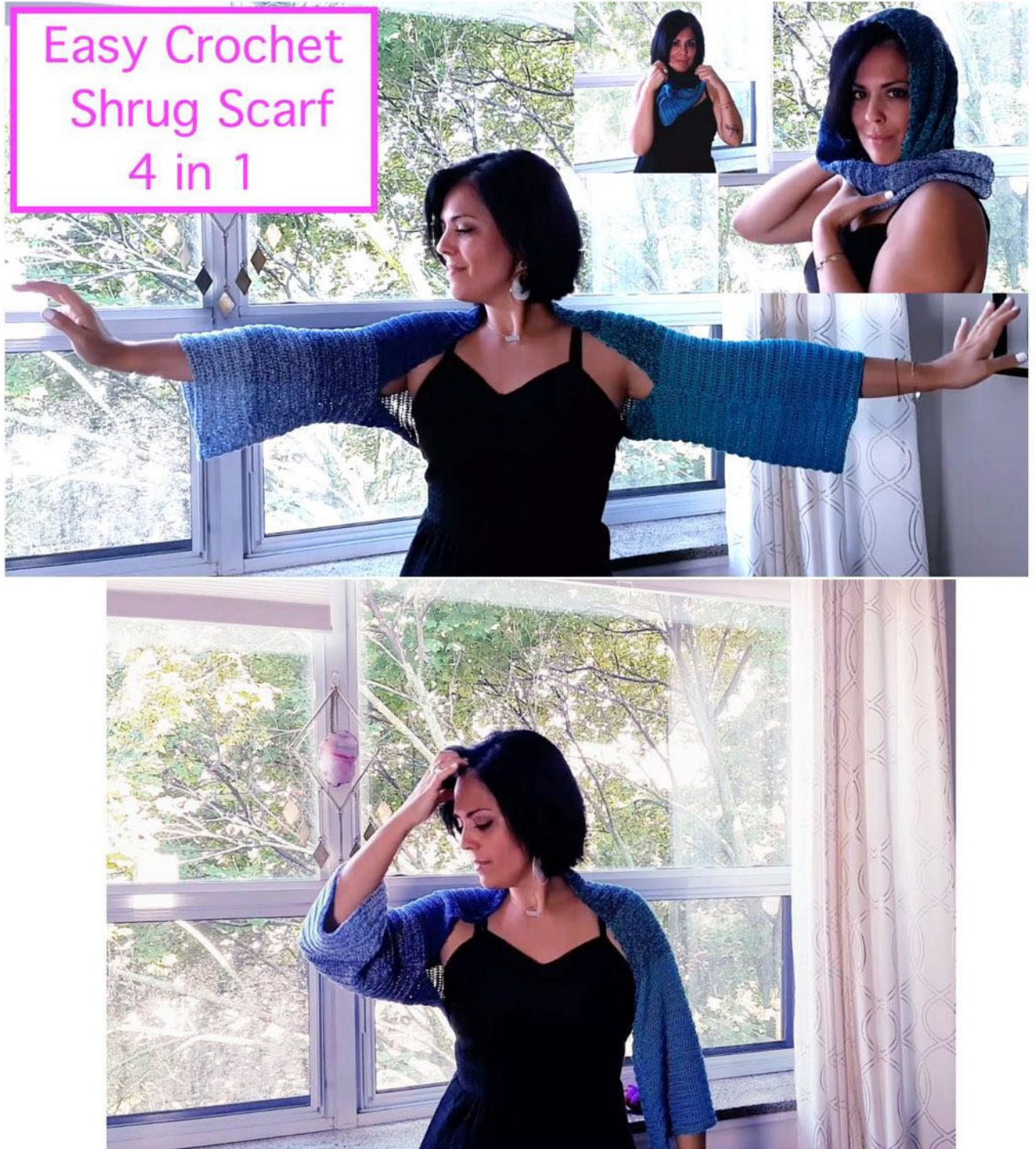


The Easy Crochet Shrug Scarf

Crochet Pattern

Easy Crochet Shrug Scarf 4 in 1



This beautiful shrug scarf can be used as a shrug, a scarf a scoodie or a cowl. It's created in one panel and you can make it a long or as short as you wish. The one pictured above measures 46 inches or 117 cm in length and it sits just a few inches shy of my wrists.

Materials	Stitch Legend
- <i>Hook</i> – 5.5 mm - <i>Yarn</i> – Fine weight 2 (Red Heart – It's a Wrap Rainbow yarn in the colour: Naurical by Red Heart was used for the shrug in this photo) * 150 grams or 570 metres approx This design is sized for a medium fit but can be customized to fit. *Please refer to free video tutorial. - <i>Scissors</i> - Yarn needle	R – row st(s) – stitch(es) ch(s) – chains(s) sl st – slip stitch HDC – half double crochet BLO – back loops only * - repeat

Pattern

Begin with a slip knot on your hook and ch 100 to begin

R – 1

- Into the 3rd ch from the hook, place 1 HDC, then continue to place 1 HDC into each chain until the end. You will now have 99 sts in total.
- Ch 1 and turn your work.

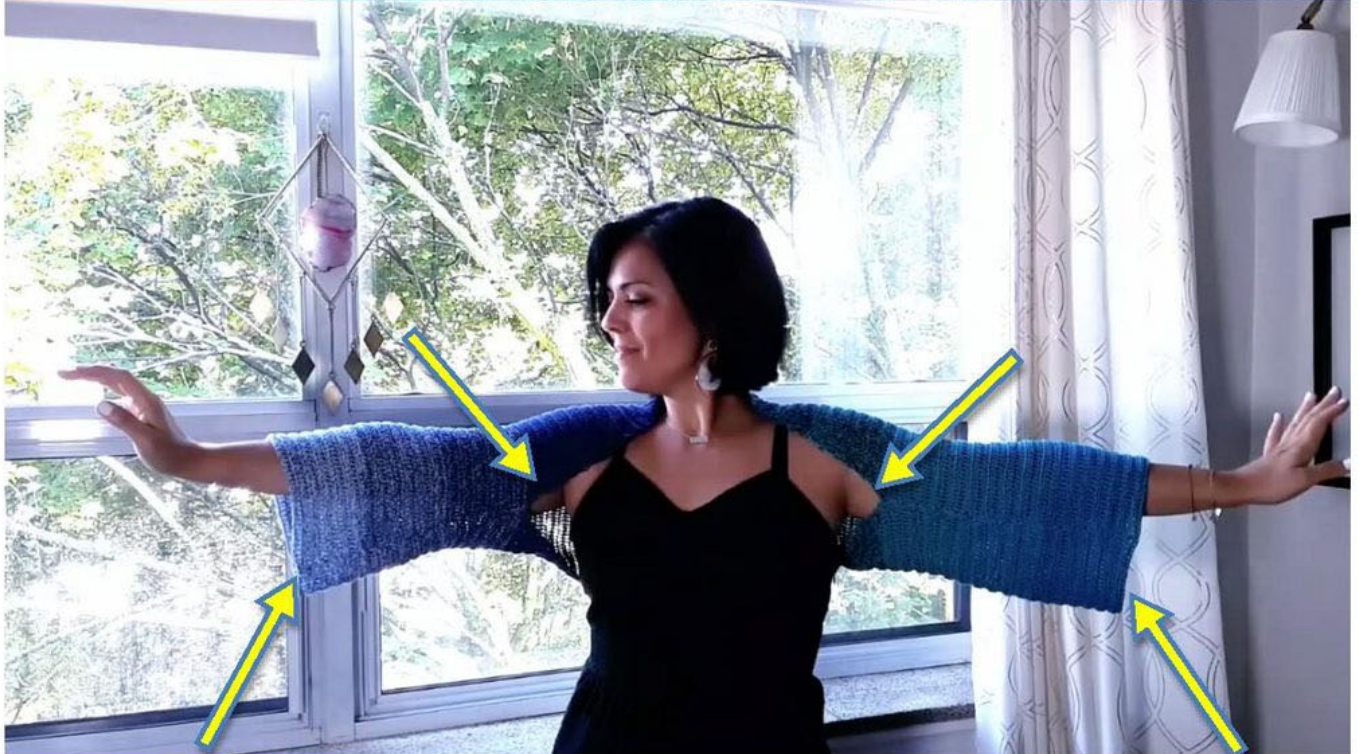
R – 2

- Into the very first st, place 1 HDC into the BLO of that st
- Continue placing 1 HDC into the BLO of every st to the end of your row
- Ch 1 and turn

R – 3 -> 135 (or until you finish your yarn. Remember to leave enough to sew your sleeve ends)

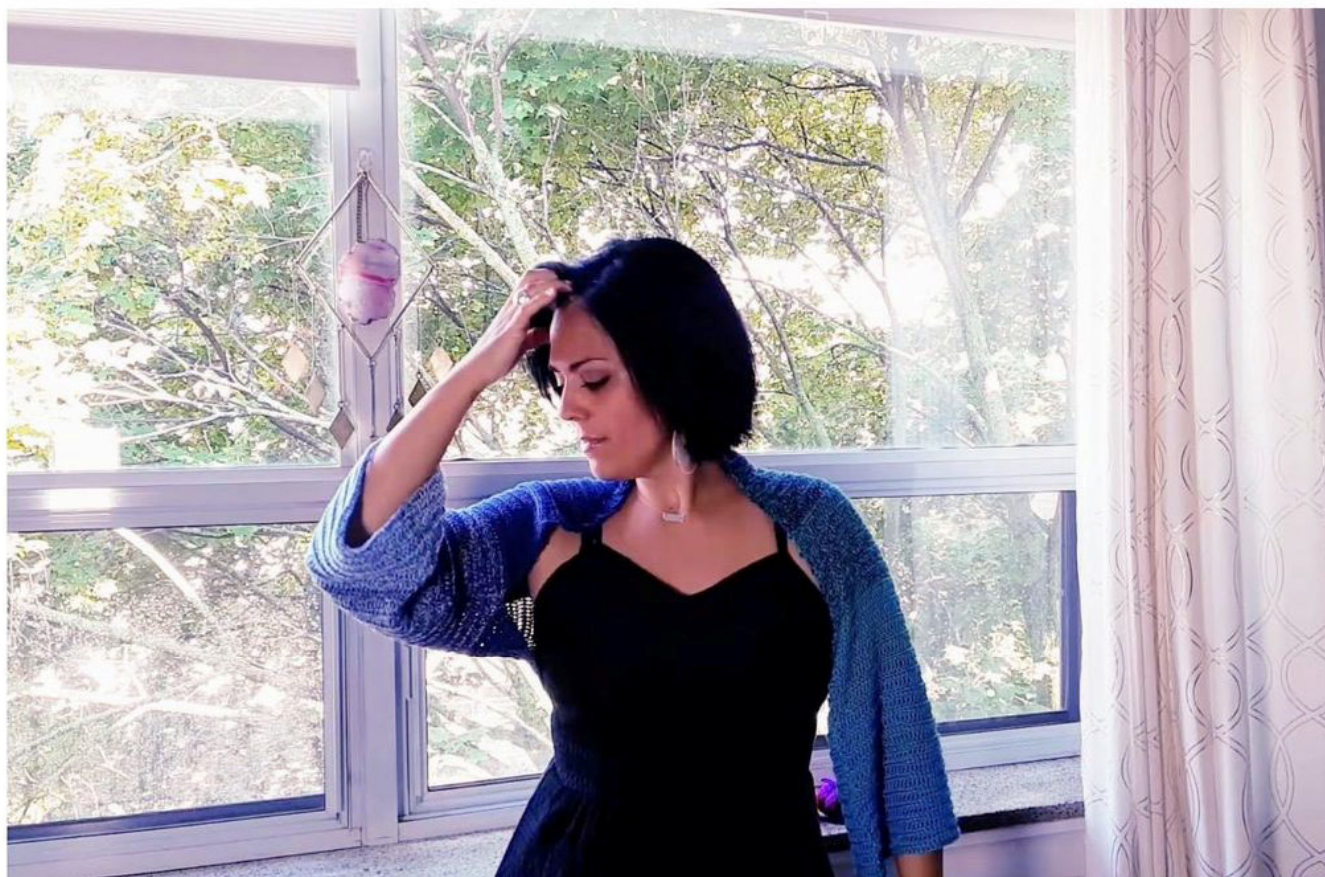
- Repeat Row 2

Once you have completed your panel, fold it in half length-wise and place pins in the approximate spots where you think it will sit on your shoulders. Then place a pin in each end to form the holes for your arms. At this point try it on to make sure the openings fit nicely.



Place your pins at these points and see how you like the fit.

Congratulations! You've completed your Shrug Scarf.
